On behalf of the MDAC, we want to congratulate the minority dealers on another spectacular year. 2021 resulted in considerable increases in both profitability and Motor Holdings buy-outs. As discussed during our winter meeting in Vegas last month, we have also continued to see an increase in the Leo Portaluppi minority dealer count while the GM dealer count as a whole has declined. A few other highlights:

- Minority dealer count by Ethnicity has grown in all four categories over the last few years.
- 98% of Minority dealers were profitable in 2021 at an average Net of almost \$4.5 million
- Our 2021 net appointment objective was 6. We added 12 New Minority Dealers.
- Currently, we have 127 approved candidates, mostly coming from existing GM dealers.

2022 MDD WINTER BUSINESS MEETING


On March 9th our Dealer Diversity Relations Team hosted our 2022 Minority Dealer Development (MDD) Winter Business Meeting in Las Vegas.

DEALER HIGHLIGHT:

This year, MDD celebrates 50 years of developing African American, Asian, Hispanic and Native American minorities for future dealership ownership opportunities. Today, minority dealers are among the most successful in the General Motors network. One of those dealers is Arnaldo Bomnin, Jr.

TAKING A RISK AND ACHIEVING A DREAM

Arnaldo Bomnin owns Bomnin Automotive Group, which operates seven franchises in South Florida and Virgina, including five top-rated GM franchises –two of which were the highest volume Chevrolet dealerships in the world in 2021. The group generated over \$1 billion of total revenue in 2021.



You might say that Arnaldo and MDD grew up in the same era. Arnaldo was two years old and living in Cuba when the program started in 1972. In 1996 he immigrated to the U.S. with his only assets -- a gold watch and three gold rings. He worked as a landscaper, picked avocados and sold

The path to success is rarely a straight line, and the same was true for Arnaldo's journey. He was in a new country, learning a new trade, and a new language, but that never discouraged him. Through determination and resilience, by 2010 Arnaldo was an experienced automotive professional and ready to make the move to owning a dealership. Although Arnaldo Bomnin Jr.'s life story is unique in many ways, he wants other minorities working in the auto industry to know that they too can be dealers, if that is their dream. "Many people fail because they trade what they want most for what they want at the moment," said Arnaldo.

During his time in the industry, he has met many people who have the talent and the desire to be a dealer, but who are held back by fear. They trade their dream of being a dealer to stay in their comfort zone. He remembers the day he was in a showroom when a visiting GM executive said he'd make a good dealer. Arnaldo heard that message "loud and clear" and soon contacted the executive to learn more about the process. "You have to be willing to take a risk," said Arnaldo. "Fear will always be present, but you cannot be afraid to dream big."

GM provides resources to help with training, financial and other start-up needs. "GM has the largest minority network in the industry," said Arnaldo. "They are out there looking for minority talent." Arnaldo said qualified minority candidates that want to become dealers should pursue that dream with confidence. "When you're ready, get on the phone and express your desire. Or, fly to Detroit, look them in the eye and tell them you want to be a dealer," he said. "And remember that your dream of owning a dealership is possible."

AUTOMOTIVE NEWS 40 UNDER 40: MANAGING PARTNER, ALPINE BUICK-GMC SOUTH



As a college intern pursuing a career in broadcast news, Laissa Sanchez became the face of Alpine Buick-GMC in Denver, appearing in TV commercials and infomercials that aired on the local Spanish Telemundo channel.

Fast-forward 15 years and Sanchez is managing partner and general manager of Alpine Buick-GMC South in Colorado Springs, Colo. "What I thought started as a one-month, one-time gig ended up being a 15-year gig," Sanchez said.

Sanchez, who has a bachelor's degree in journalism and with a minor in marketing from Metropolitan State University in Denver, said she realized during the filming of those commercials that she had a passion for auto retail.

In 2011, she officially went to work for Alpine Buick-GMC in Denver after appearing in the store's commercials for years.

"I started in sales, and I worked myself up all the way to GM," Sanchez said. "I worked in every position. I was in finance, used-car manager, new-car manager." Years later, dealership owners Ivette Dominguez, an Automotive News 100 Leading Women in the North American Auto Industry honoree in 2020, and Mike Drawe, gave Sanchez her big break: They offered the then-general manager the opportunity to become a managing partner in a new store. Sanchez and Dominguez acquired Alpine Buick-GMC South in November 2018.

With Sanchez at the store's helm, vehicle sales more than tripled in 2019 compared with 2018, she said. The sales gains led the store to the No. 1 spot for both GMC and Buick in its region in 2019, an achievement the store has maintained, Sanchez said.

Last year presented new challenges. Amid the early months of the coronavirus pandemic, vehicle sales at the dealership were prohibited. So Sanchez helped create an online showroom for vehicle purchases and a no-contact service concierge program. "We rose to the occasion and used technology to our favor, and we became a full-service online dealership," she said.

Sanchez now aims to spend more time in the community and working with charities. She'd like to encourage more women to work at dealerships and more students to pursue auto retail as a career path.

"We need to make the auto industry more appealing to these new generations," she said.

GM's Minority Dealer Development Network Program underwent a comprehensive review in 2021 and has implemented changes to the program.

- The minimum capital investment requirement for all prospective candidates has increased from \$350,000 to \$500,000 of unencumbered funds at the time of submitting application. For private cap candidates the minimum remains at \$750,000. The increase reflects the escalating costs of automotive dealerships in today's market.
- Due to the current environment our Dealer assessment is now converted to 100% virtual until further notice.
